

WORKING WITH CHILDREN CHECK – WWCC

BRLSC has a strong commitment to Child and Youth Protection, as required by the State Legislation implemented on 1 January 2017. We will be championing LSV's slogan "Safeguarding Children and Young People is everyone's business". In doing so we are continuing to develop our club as a safe and inclusive space for all members.

All members aged 18 years and over are required to have a WWCC as a condition of membership with Black Rock LSC and Life Saving Victoria.

Use this link http://www.workingwithchildren.vic.gov.au/utility/home/ to:

- Apply for a **new WWCC card** no charge for voluntary cards
- **Renew** an existing card can be done 6 months prior to expiry
- Update an existing card to include Black Rock LSC & LSV
- Create a login to MyCheck notifies you 28 days in advance of expiry

2. Review

• Verify your Identity

- Identity verification (Please click the link below for ID requirements http://www.workingwithchildren.vic.gov.au/home/applications/lodging+your+application/proof+of+identity+requirements/)
 - Verify online by following the prompts and entering the details of two primary ID documents (you will also need to present one acceptable photo ID document at Australia Post). OR
 - Verify at Australia Post, by taking three original proof of ID documents, that when combined, show your full name, DOB and photo.

3. Consent and declaration

 Regardless of the option you choose to verify your identity, you will need to finalise your application at Australia Post. Your nearest participating Australia Post outlet can be found here https://auspost.com.au/locate/post-office/working-with-children-check-vic

Receiving your Working with Children Check

Once you lodge at Australia Post you will be issued with a receipt which acts as your temporary card until the hard copy card arrives in the mail, please email the receipt to <u>membership@brlsc.org.au</u>
